Dear Families,

Unbelievably, we only have one week left of this half term. If you haven't already, please be reminded that there is an opportunity to book in a teacher/parent meeting for next week. On Saturday 11th March, Coose Trannack Cross Country races are taking place. This is a great opportunity for children to take on longstanding cross-country course! There are races for all year groups:
